Aug 17	<u>National Senior</u> <u>Citizens Day</u>			Today is National Senior Citizens Day. Ronald Reagan established the observance in 1988 to recognize the value older Americans bring to the nation, and to raise awareness of their needs. As of the 2020 census, 1 in 6 Americans were over 65.	
Aug 19	<u>National Aviation</u> <u>Day</u>			National Aviation Day was established by FDR in 1939, on the anniversary of aviation pioneer Orville Wright's birthday. See if you have an aviation museum or air show near you.

Sep 1	<u>Labor Day</u>	If you or someone you know lost health insurance because they lost a job or hours, remember job loss may be a qualifying life event for Special Enrollment for individual and family coverage. Contact (me/us) if you would like to know more.		In the 1800's, workers worked 12- hour days 7 days a week to make ends meet. Children as young as 5 worked in factories. After years of organized labor efforts to protect worker rights, Grover Cleveland established Labor Day in 1894. The first Monday of September honors laborers, and today, marks the end of Summer and return to school (a different definition of labor!)

September	<u>Healthy Aging</u> <u>Month</u>	September is Healthy Aging Month. Remember most health plans cover annual checkups and as many as 25 screenings annually at no added cost to you. Schedule appointments soon. Some doctors book up months ahead, and 2025 is nearly over!		
September	<u>National</u> <u>Childhood</u> <u>Obesity</u> <u>Awareness</u> <u>Month</u>	As kids go back to school, support healthy diet with new recipes. See if your plan includes wellness offerings that include nutrition tips.		
September	<u>National Sickle</u> <u>Cell Awareness</u> <u>Month</u>		About 100,000 people in the United States have this inherited blood disorder. Their red blood cells are hardened and misshapen and don't circulate well in the body, which leads to tissue and organ damage. (Add ethnic balance info.)	
September	<u>Blood Cancer</u> <u>Awareness</u> <u>Month</u>		About every 3 minutes, one person in the US is diagnosed with leukemia, lymphoma or myeloma. More than six people every hour die from blood cancer. This Blood Cancer Awareness Month, take a moment to learn about detection and treatment advances.

September	<u>Childhood</u> <u>Cancer</u> <u>Awareness</u> <u>Month</u>		Pediatric cancers are the leading cause of death from disease in children between the ages of 1 and 14 years. However, the five-year survival rate for pediatric cancer has increased from 58- 68% in the 1970s to 83- 88% in recent years.		
September	<u>Ovarian Cancer</u> <u>Awareness</u> <u>Month</u>	September is Ovarian and Gynecologic Cancer Awareness Month. Remember most health plans cover recommended regular gynecologic checkups and related screenings. Schedule appointments soon. Some doctors book up months ahead, and 2025 is nearly over!	More than 20,000 women are projected to be diagnosed with Ovarian Cancer in 2025. 5-year survival for all stages is just 46%, but that jumps to 92% if the cancer is caught early, but symptoms are often overlooked. This Ovarian and Gynecologic Cancer Awareness Month, learn more about risks and detection for the women in your life.		
September	<u>Prostate Health</u> <u>and Cancer</u> <u>Awareness</u> <u>Month</u>	September is Prostate Cancer Awareness Month. Remember most health plans annual checkups and as many as 25 screenings at no added cost. Schedule appointments soon. Some doctors book up months ahead, and 2025 is nearly over!	September is Prostate Cancer Awareness Month. Nearly 300,000 men are diagnosed every year, and 35,000 die. 5-year survival rate is high at 97%, but that depends on healthy lifestyle and recommended screening.
